Dr. Lewin, a national educator on hereditary genetics, cancer survivorship, has authored or co-authored over 100 articles, abstracts, book chapters, and made many presentations at scholarly conferences. She is a recipient of the President's Award from the Society of Gynecologic Oncology and New York Presbyterian's prestigious Physician of the Year Award.

A member of the advisory board of Sharsheret, a Teaneck-based national nonprofit organization, her personal mission is "to help stamp out hereditary cancers". Sharsheret has worked with local hospitals and other organizations since it was founded in 2001. It has entered into a formal partnership with Holy Name Medical Center, where Dr. Lewin is the medical director of gynecologic oncology.
