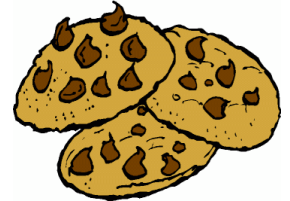
“A TASTE OF KADIMA”
